This institute will prepare participants to investigate, write, and present grievances, plus draft and present arbitration cases. Participants will have the opportunity to practice and further develop what they learn in two live online sessions:

Thursday, April 15, 4:00 - 6:00 pm (central)

Practice asking examination questions, opening statements, and closing statements.

Thursday, April 22, 4:00 - 6:00 pm (central)

Present an arbitration case before an arbitrator.
