About the institute

Improve your skills in representing injured workers with an in-depth examination of filing claims and representing workers before administrative law judges at the Department of Workforce Development. This institute is intended for representatives with a working knowledge of the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation system, whether from previous instruction or job-site experience. This class can be combined with the Intro to Worker's Compensation for a refresher before diving deeper. Participants will apply their new skills in a mock hearing before an administrative law judge.
