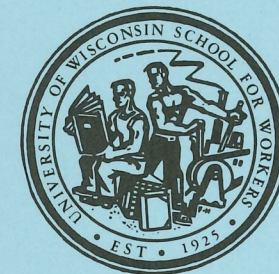

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Workplace Toxics Law

This is a one-day program for union representatives and rank and file workers. The training will focus on worker/union rights to information about toxic substances in the workplace. Both OSHA's new Hazard Communication Standard and Wisconsin's recently-enacted "Right-to-Know" law impose significant obligations on employers and provide valuable rights to unions and workers.

Our keynote speaker, Frank Mirer, Director of Safety & Health, United Auto Workers, Detroit, will provide an update on OSHA activities. Other speakers in the program will include representatives from OSHA, the Wisconsin Section of Occupational Health (DILHR), as well as School for Workers faculty.

Additional topics to be covered include understanding a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS); assessing exposure limits and other sources of hazard information.
